

A Bird's Eye View of De Wildhoeve

General approx. 12 hectares, 360 camping and caravan pitches, 25 permanent pitches, rental of Astro, Artcamp, Forest Houses, Forest Cabins, Forest Tent, and Safari tents **Food and Drink** brasserie, snack bar, terrace
Pitches electricity 0.55 per kWh (8-10 amp), cable TV, wastewater drainage, water connection, WiFi internet
Recreation outdoor theatre, BMX track, walking and cycling tours, recreation program (during NBT school holidays), recreation hall, play equipment, sports field for e.g. football and volleyball, 3 playgrounds, tennis court, water playground, jeu de boules court **Internet** WiFi internet on the pitch
Sanitary Facilities 4 heated sanitary buildings, toilets, washing cubicles, 8 baby rooms, shower and toilet with hoist for the disabled, shower trolley, family showers, "Bear bathroom" with tree shower, children's disabled facility, massage shower, "Badger forest bathroom" for children
Laundry 6 washing machines, 3 tumble dryers **Shop** supermarket **Swimming Pool** indoor pool with White Magic slide (40m) with time measurement, bubble bench, toddler and pre-school pool with wood nymph, outdoor pool with slide and spray park **Indoor playground** The Badger Burrow – an adventurous 180 m² indoor playground for children aged 1 to 10, where play and nature take centre stage.

Reserving, booking & payment

Arrival and Departure Determine your own arrival and departure day when reserving your camping pitch. The rental accommodations, however, have fixed arrival and departure days. Arrival at the campsite is after 2:00 PM, and departure is before 12:00 PM. Arrival at the rental accommodations is after 3:00 PM and departure is before 10:30 AM.

Maximum number of persons The accommodation you rent (Astro, Artcamp, Boshuis, Boshut, and Safari tent) may not be occupied by more persons than the indicated numbers.

Seasonal arrangements The seasonal arrangements are personal and valid for a maximum of 2 people, excluding tourist tax.

Electricity Electricity consumption is exclusive and will be settled based on usage (0.55 per kWh).

Ascension/Pentecost (Whitsun) During the Ascension and Pentecost periods, reservations can only be made within the fixed periods (see rates).

... and other useful information

Facilities Our shop, snack bar, brasserie, and indoor pool are open all season. There are adjusted opening hours in the low season and shoulder season. The outdoor pool is open from 01/05 to 01/09..

Internet WiFi is available at our campsite. To connect, you can choose from one of the following networks: Wildhoeve 1, 2, or 3, depending on your location on the campsite. Please note that the Wi-Fi at the campsite is intended for general use and does not have the same performance as at home.

Visitors Your visitors are also very welcome, of course. They are required to report to reception. Visitors must have left the campsite before 10:00 PM. You are responsible for the behaviour of your visitors. Visitors may use the swimming pools after payment.

Extras Children up to 2 years old camp for free. One small side tent (max. 5 m²) is included per pitch.

Night Rest Many people with children stay at Camping de Wildhoeve. Therefore, it must be quiet on the campsite in the evening, especially after 11:00 PM.

Reservation and payment After your booking, you will receive a reservation confirmation. We expect half of the stated amount within 14 days. Only then is your reservation final. The remaining amount must be paid no later than 6 weeks before arrival. If booking within 6 weeks before arrival, the entire amount must be paid at once. Your bank or post office account statement is proof of payment; you will not receive a further notification of this.

Booking change In certain cases, we reserve the right to rebook you to a different camping pitch or a different accommodation.

Cancellation All agreements fall under the Recron conditions. In the event of cancellation, these conditions and the associated costs come into effect. We strongly advise you to take out cancellation insurance.



Not Allowed Dogs (including visitors' dogs), party tents, open fires, drones, fat bikes and e-scooters are not permitted on the campsite.

Cars Cars are not allowed on the camping grounds. On the day of arrival and actual departure, you may drive onto the grounds to set up or pick up your camping gear, respectively. On the intermediate days, you must park in one of the parking spaces. For temporary transport of luggage or groceries, you can use trolleys (or baggage carts).

Motorcycles and Mopeds Motorcycles and mopeds are not permitted. However, they can be stored (unattended) in consultation.
